

## 2008 Derby Rules

- 1) All Fishermen must adhere to Washington State Fishing Rules and Regulations
- 2) Derby Fish may be caught in any "Open" Puget Sound Marine Area
- 3) Everyone fishing in the same boat must have a Derby Ticket. Kids 14 and under are eligible for kids prizes in addition to the regular prizes. All adults are limited to only one prize, kids limited to only one adult prize and one kids prize.
- 4) Derby Fish can only be caught between daylight and 1:00PM, Saturday, August 2nd, 2008
- 5) All Derby Fish must be transported by boat, via water to either Des Moines Marina, Dock Street Marina in Tacoma or Seacrest Marina in Seattle
- 6) The Weigh Stations will operate between the hours of 8:00AM until 1:00PM on Saturday, August 2nd, 2008. Time of weigh in will be used as a tiebreaker. Fishermen **MUST** be in line by 1:00PM. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
- 7) All Fish must be weighed in round, not cleaned and dressed
- 8) All Derby Fish must be weighed, marked and logged in by a Derby Official and signed by the contestant to be eligible for awards
- 9) All Fish **MUST** be cleaned by a Derby Official, only **AFTER** weigh in. Any foreign substance found in a fish will automatically disqualify the entry
- 10) Any Fish that appears to be altered in any way will be disqualified without recourse
- 11) The decisions of the Derby Officials are **FINAL**
- 12) Attendance at the awards and photo ceremony are requested to receive prizes
- 13) All derby tickets purchased will enter the purchaser in to the drawing by the Northwest Derby Series for a new boat
- 14) With the purchase of a Derby Ticket, Persons entering the Derby and/or providing assistance to the Derby Officials or Contestants do so at their own free will and thereby hold the Sponsors, City of Des Moines, Dock Street Marina, Seacrest Marina, and the Puget Sound Anglers and anyone else involved harmless for any damages or claims that may arise
